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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Since its inception in 2002, the Hospital Preparedness Program (HPP) has continued to evolve to meet the changing needs of the healthcare system, to incorporate new threats, and bring together new partners who play an integral role in healthcare preparedness, response, and recovery. Supported by the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR), and HPP allocated funds, the nation's healthcare coalitions focus on bringing together a wide array of health care entities to ensure community preparedness. These diverse healthcare and response organizations work to increase collaboration and capabilities related to preparing for and responding to emergencies, natural disasters, and other crises.

Colorado's North Central Region Healthcare Coalition (NCR HCC), established from three existing coalitions, now chapters, in 2017, focuses on developing and promoting healthcare emergency preparedness and response capabilities across the region, including the counties of: Adams, Arapahoe, Boulder, Broomfield, Clear Creek, Denver, Douglas, Elbert, Gilpin, and Jefferson.

The strategic priorities outlined in this report serve as pillars of support for the ongoing planning, response, and recovery activities within the NCR HCC, its associated chapters, member agencies, and key stakeholders. The associated projects and initiatives serve to enhance *regional* health and medical preparedness, response, and recovery capabilities and are in alignment with the NCR HCC's mission and purpose:

Mission:

Colorado's NCR HCC exists to promote, develop and enhance the region's cross-jurisdictional and cross-disciplinary coordination to the health and medical component of incident preparedness, response and recovery. This is achieved through communication, planning, training, and collaboration, with coalition partners.

Purpose:

The purpose of the NCR HCC is to develop a coordinated and effective medical and public health system response to events that impact the health and medical system through:

- Effective information sharing and situational awareness
- Strategic identification of resources
- Identification and mitigation of key capability and capacity gaps
- Collaborative prevention, mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery activities

The projects described in this plan are categorized into one or more *strategic priorities*. These priorities, developed by the NCR HCC Governance Board, represent those foundational elements that are necessary to support the continued development, strengthening, operationalization, and sustainment of the coalition. The strategic priorities, as approved by the NCR HCC Governance Board, include:

- 1. Engagement
- 2. Operational Support
- 3. Situational Awareness
- 4. Training and Exercise
- 5. Sustainability

In addition to the strategic priorities described above, the NCR HCC is also committed to prioritizing activities that support the <u>2017-2022 Healthcare Preparedness and Response Capabilities</u> developed by the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response (ASPR):

- 1. Foundation for Healthcare and Medical Readiness
- 2. Healthcare and Medical Response Coordination
- 3. Continuity of Healthcare Service Delivery
- 4. Medical Surge

This strategic plan has provides the NCR HCC Governance Board, staff, chapters, coalition members, and stakeholders with guidance on coalition activities, coordination initiatives, and project development. The scope and content of this document is intended to be fluid and will be amended, as necessary.

The plan outlined below is designed to be complimentary to the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment Office of Emergency Preparedness and Response's (CDPHE-OEPR) 2019-2020 Hospital Preparedness Program Statement of Work (Appendix A).

The North Central Region Healthcare Coalition 2020-2024 Strategic Plan was reviewed and approved by the NCR HCC Governance Board on September 22, 2020.
